

National foreword

This standard is an adoption and is identical to ISO 28000: 2022(E) Security and resilience —Security management systems —Requirements published by the International Organization for Standardization.

Scope of the standard

This document specifies requirements for a security management system, including aspects relevant to the supply chain.

This document is applicable to all types and sizes of organizations (e.g. commercial enterprises, government or other public agencies and non-profit organizations) which intend to establish, implement, maintain and improve a security management system. It provides a holistic and common approach and is not industry or sector specific.

This document can be used throughout the life of the organization and can be applied to any activity, internal or external, at all levels.

Where the words 'International Standard' appear, referring to this standard, they should be read as 'Jamaican Standard'.

Where reference is made to informative and normative annexes the following definitions should be noted:

- Informative Annex gives additional information intended to assist in the understanding or use of the document. They do not contain requirements.
- Normative Annex gives provisions additional to those in the body of a document. They contain requirements.

Users should note that all standards undergo revision from time to time and that any reference made herein to any standard implies its latest edition, unless otherwise stated.

This standard is voluntary.
